Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

TerraMed Limited is committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions across our operations and value chain by 2050, in line with UK Government and NHS targets.

As a small-scale medical distribution company and approved NHS supplier, we continue to develop the structures, systems and insights necessary to measure, report and reduce our emissions in line with best practice. We aim to embed sustainable practices throughout our operations, with annual progress reporting and longer-term roadmap planning.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

TerraMed began formal operations in early 2024 and completed its first full year of carbon data collection for the period 1 March 2024 to 28 February 2025, which serves as our baseline year. Emissions calculations follow the GHG Protocol Corporate Standard and the SECR framework, using the operational control approach and including all relevant facilities (office and warehouse).

Baseline Year Emissions: 1 March 2025 – 28 February 2026

The table below presents TerraMed's emissions for the current reporting year alongside the baseline, allowing direct comparison. A modest increase versus baseline is observed, reflecting the company's continued growth in distribution volumes and increased supplier engagement activity during this period.

The overall increase of approximately 7.2% against baseline is primarily attributable to higher distribution volumes, increased supplier engagement requiring additional travel, and greater warehouse throughput as the business has grown. This increase is proportionate to the company's growth trajectory and does not represent a deterioration in operational carbon efficiency. We remain committed to decoupling

emissions growth from business growth over the coming years, and to tracking carbon intensity (tCO₂e per £ revenue) as a more meaningful long-term performance metric.

Carbon Reduction Initiatives

We recognise that as a small-scale NHS medical supplier, our environmental impact may be modest compared to larger operators. Nonetheless, we are committed to embedding carbon-conscious principles into the foundation of our company from the outset. Our initiatives are divided between actions already taken and those we intend to implement over the next 12 to 24 months.

Current Initiatives (Already in Place)

- **Remote-First Operational Model:** Most administrative functions are carried out by remote-working staff, eliminating the need for daily commuting, office heating, and lighting, while supporting employee wellbeing.
- **Minimal Air Travel:** We do not engage in frequent domestic or international air travel. Supplier engagement and client meetings are conducted remotely wherever possible, with low-carbon alternatives prioritised for any necessary travel.
- **Digital-First Communication:** We use Microsoft Teams, Zoom, Google Meet, and other cloud-based platforms for supplier engagement, internal coordination, and project delivery.
- **Centralised UK Warehousing:** All logistics operations are routed through a single UK warehouse, minimising vehicle movements, reducing transport duplication, and enabling consistent emissions tracking.
- **Supplier Pre-Screening:** All prospective suppliers are subject to rigorous pre-engagement checks, including review of technical documentation, certifications, and environmental practices where available.
- **Public Reporting and Website Transparency:** This Carbon Reduction Plan is published at www.terramed.co.uk/policies in line with NHS supplier transparency expectations and PPN 06/21 requirements.

Planned Initiatives (Next 12–24 Months)

Building on the structure we have already put in place, we are preparing to implement more advanced environmental measures and expand our carbon reporting scope. The following activities are scheduled for development or execution over the next 12 to 24 months:

- **NHS Evergreen Assessment Completion:** Complete the Evergreen Supplier Sustainability Assessment in 2026 to benchmark current performance against NHS criteria and identify priority improvement areas, even where no level is awarded at this stage.
- **Scope 3 Emissions Expansion:** Broaden Scope 3 reporting to include upstream freight and logistics, packaging materials, waste disposal, and purchased goods and services, engaging supply chain partners to improve data quality.
- **Carbon Intensity Metric:** Introduce a carbon intensity measure (tCO₂e per £ revenue or per shipment unit) to enable meaningful year-on-year comparisons that account for business growth and avoid misleading absolute figures.

- **Environmental Policy Publication:** Finalise and publish a formal Environmental Policy covering waste reduction, energy efficiency, ethical sourcing, and compliance, accessible via our website.
- **Net Zero Roadmap:** Publish a practical roadmap toward Net Zero by 2050 or earlier, with interim carbon intensity targets and actionable milestones, including evaluation of verified offsetting options.
- **Supplier Engagement Programme:** Initiate a structured programme to engage suppliers on sustainability, requesting Net Zero declarations and prioritising partners who actively measure and report their own emissions.
- **Gap Analysis and Methodology Review:** Conduct a formal gap analysis of current emissions reporting processes to identify data blind spots and design a consistent calculation methodology across all scopes.
- **Science-Based Targets Exploration:** Explore alignment with the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) and broader NHS Net Zero Supplier Roadmap as the company matures and reporting processes are formalised.

Through these planned activities, we intend to move beyond basic compliance and work toward fully integrating environmental sustainability into our core operations, supplier relationships, and future strategic planning.

Declaration and Sign-Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and the associated reporting guidance. Emissions have been reported in line with:

- The GHG Protocol Corporate Standard,
- The SECR framework (Scope 1 and 2),
- The Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard, and
- Official UK Government emissions conversion factors.
